

German - Art Deco era - Cut Corners Square Case with Quadrant Designed Veneer - (circa 1930s)



Art Deco era - Cut Corners Square Wall Clock with an Externally Swinging Pendulum

Here is an interesting Art Deco era wall clock made in Germany in the 1930s.

The mahogany veneer design on the front of the case is done in 45 degree angles in a quadrant pattern. The case measures 12-5/8" x 12-5/8" and is 4" deep.

The dial has gold tones hour markers. An externally swinging pendulum complements the Art Deco design.

This clock has an 8-day German made movement.
