**Custom Made - Colonial Style - Tall Case Clock - Solid Walnut -
(circa 1960s)**

This custom made tall case clock was designed in the early American Colonial style.

The case was made in the 1960s in North Carolina from local solid walnut wood.

The case is 87" high x 18-1/2" wide x 12" deep.

The square brass dial features Arabic numerals with fancy engraved designs and fancy spandrels.

The lunette features a picture of a full masked clipper ship sailing in the open sea.

I purchased and installed a brand new Hermle 8-day movement that has Westminster chimes (quarter, half, three quarter and top of the hour with a gong at the top of the hour as well) and is chain wound.

All the brass on the weights and pendulum bob are in new condition.

The clock case was completely restored inside and out by me. It has four coats of tung oil finish that gives it a brilliant shine and just makes the beautiful walnut wood grain just jump out at you.

This is a beautiful custom clock that is in excellent condition (cosmetically and mechanically.)
