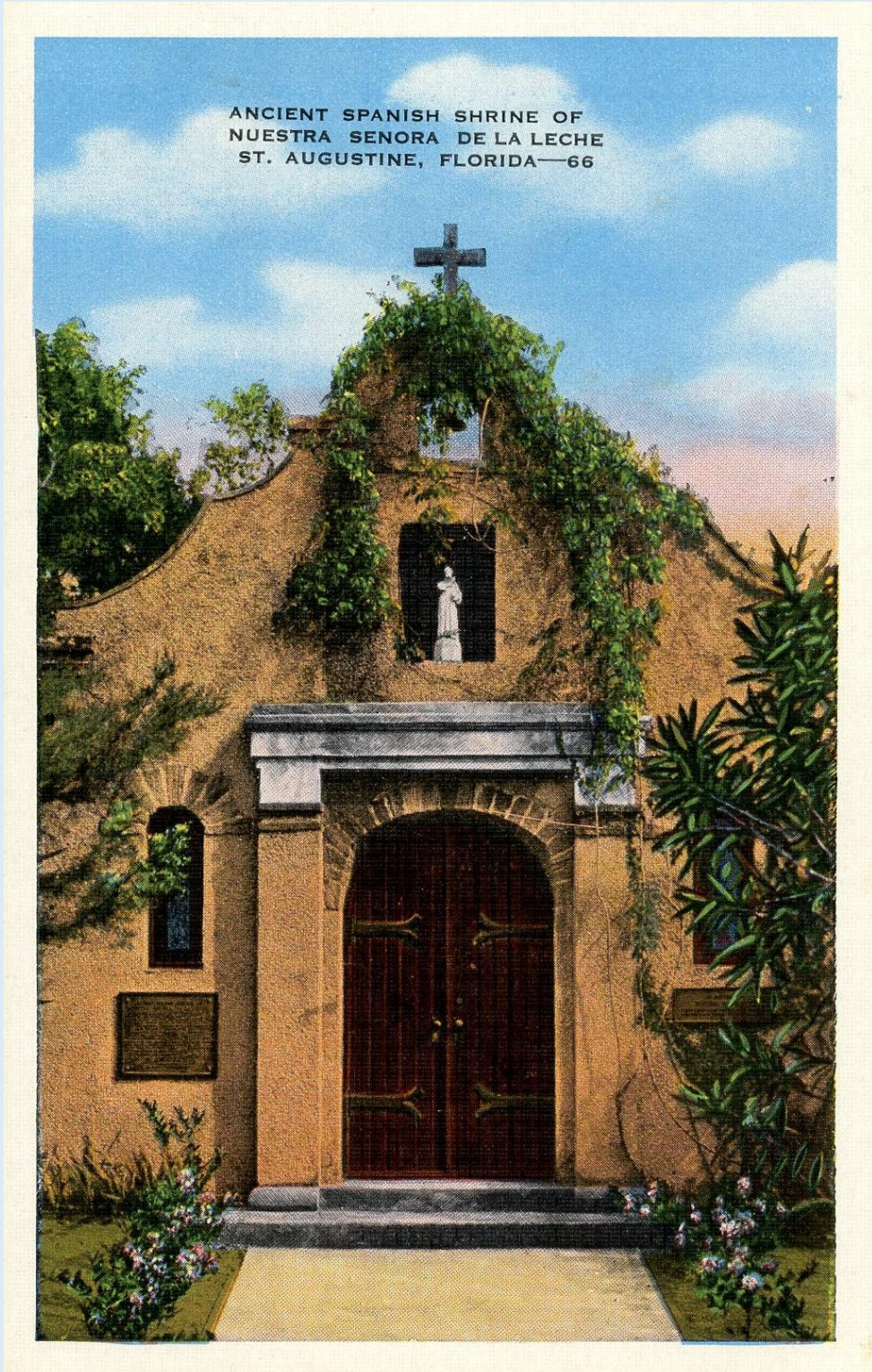

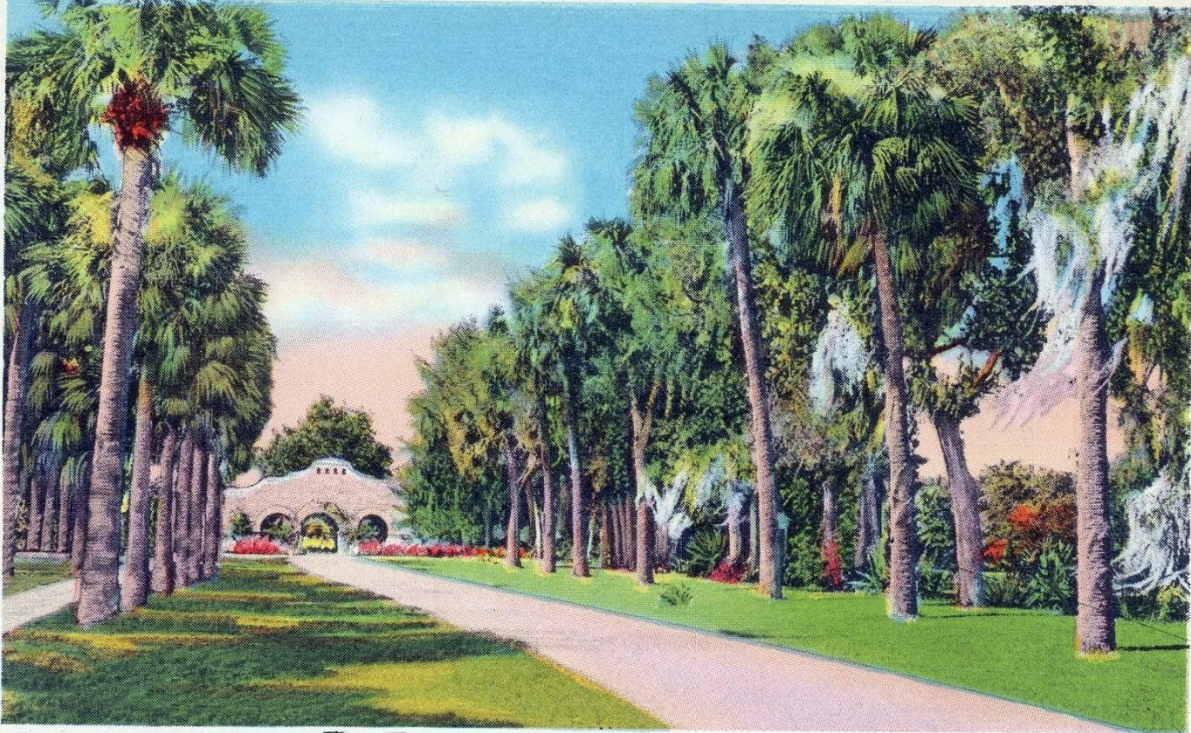

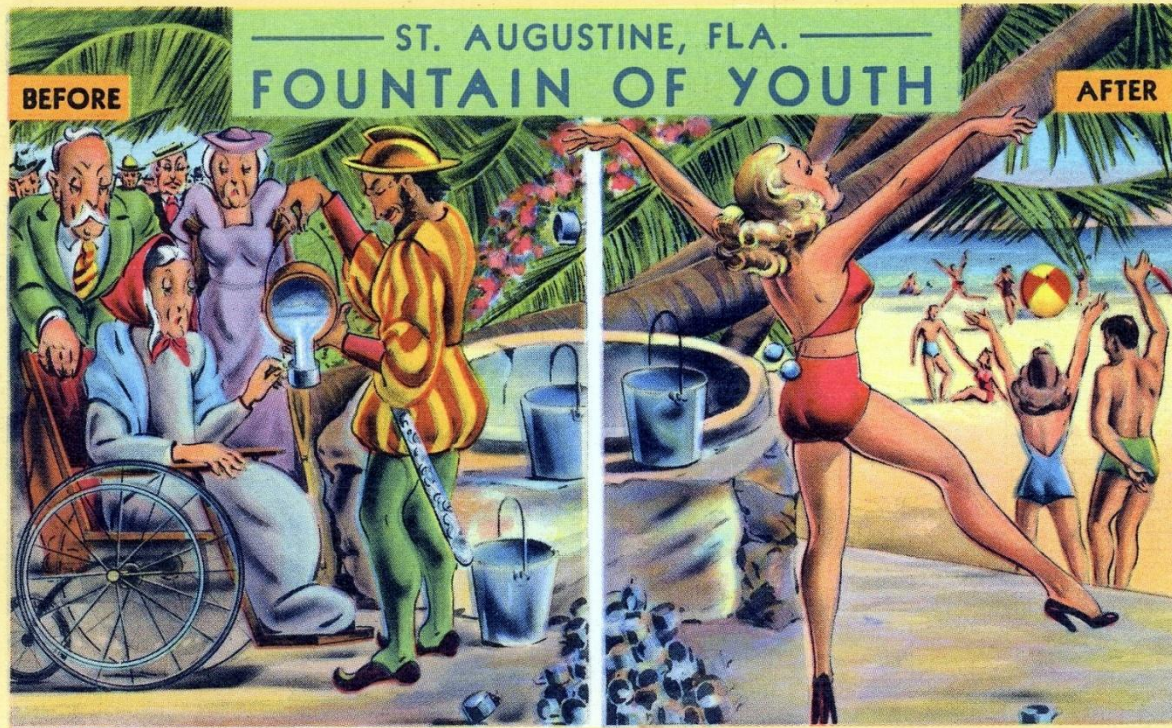

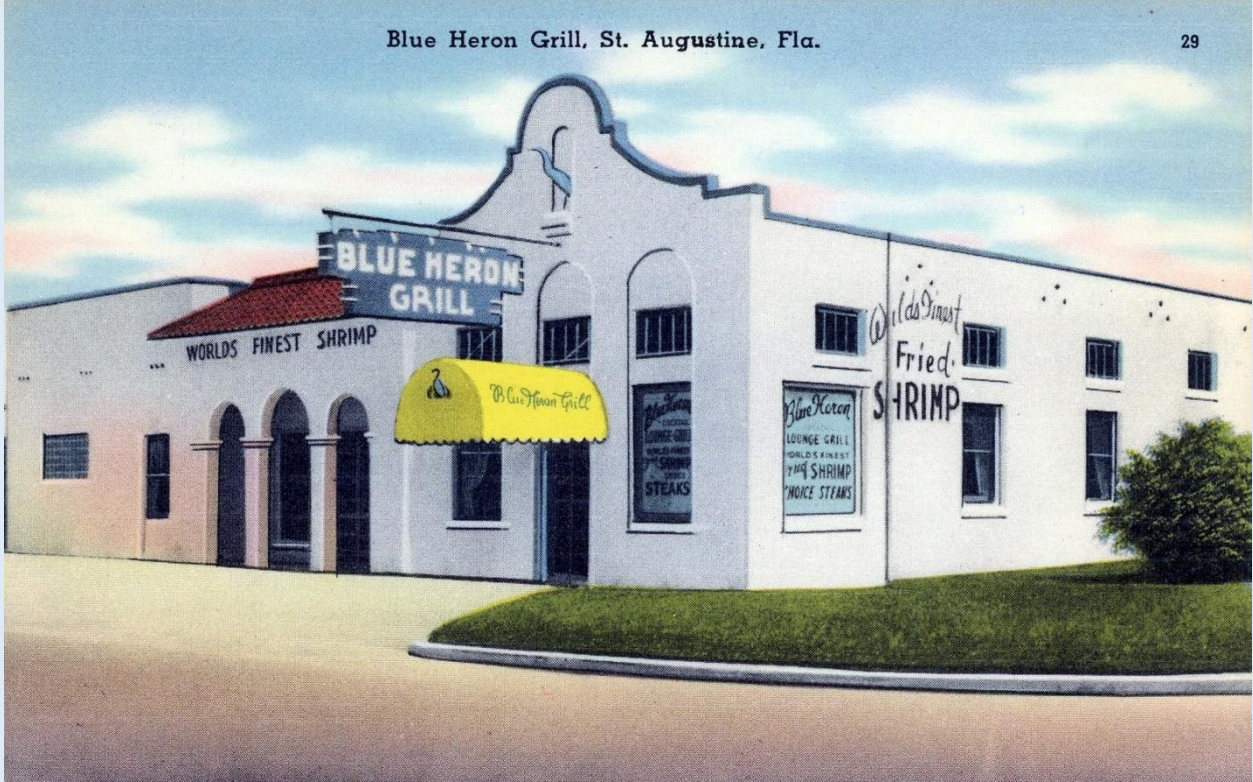

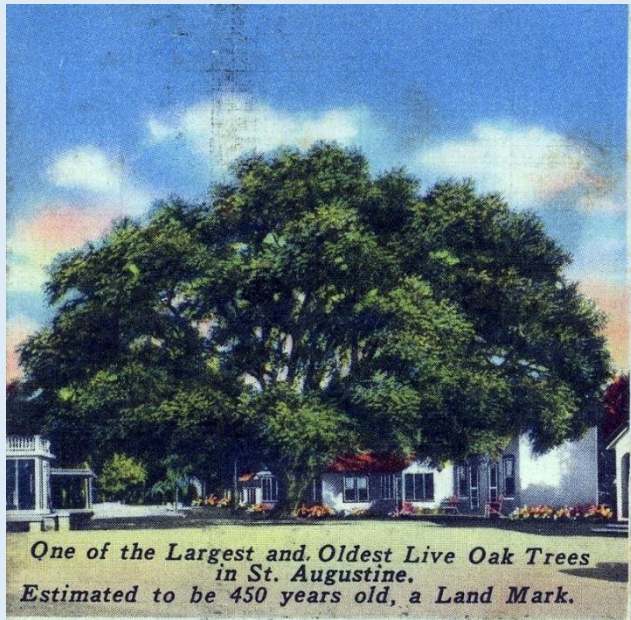

The Million Dollar Live Oak Tree above in the center of the Court should be seen by everyone interested in the natural beauty of St. Augustine.

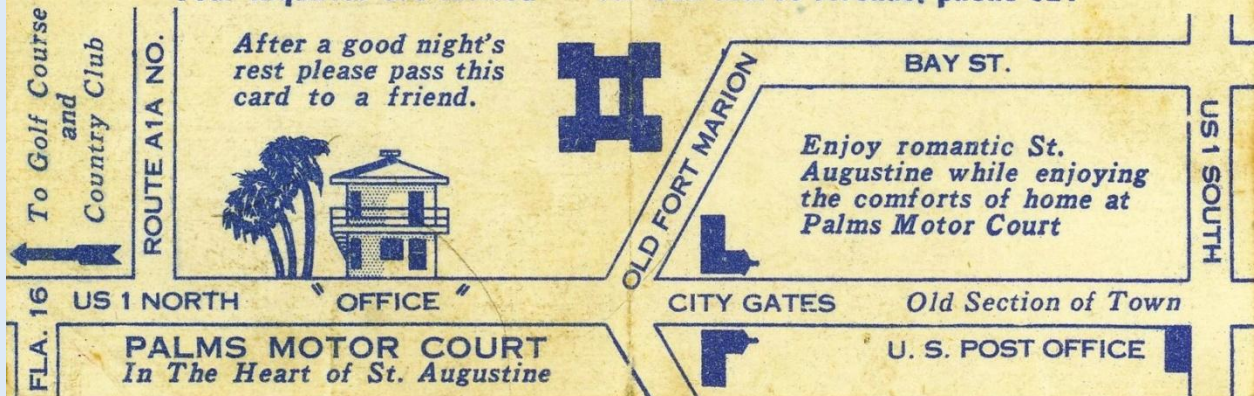

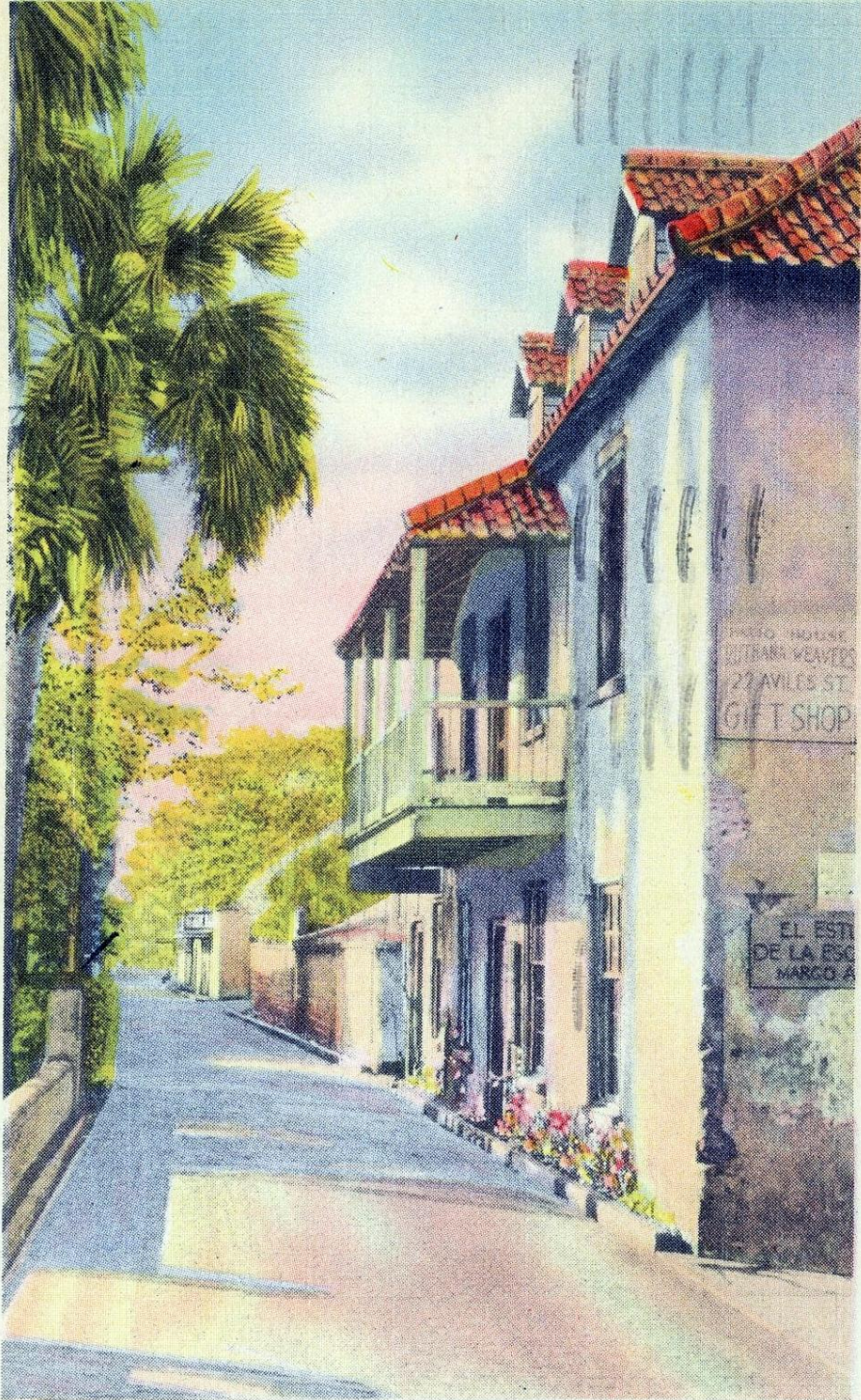

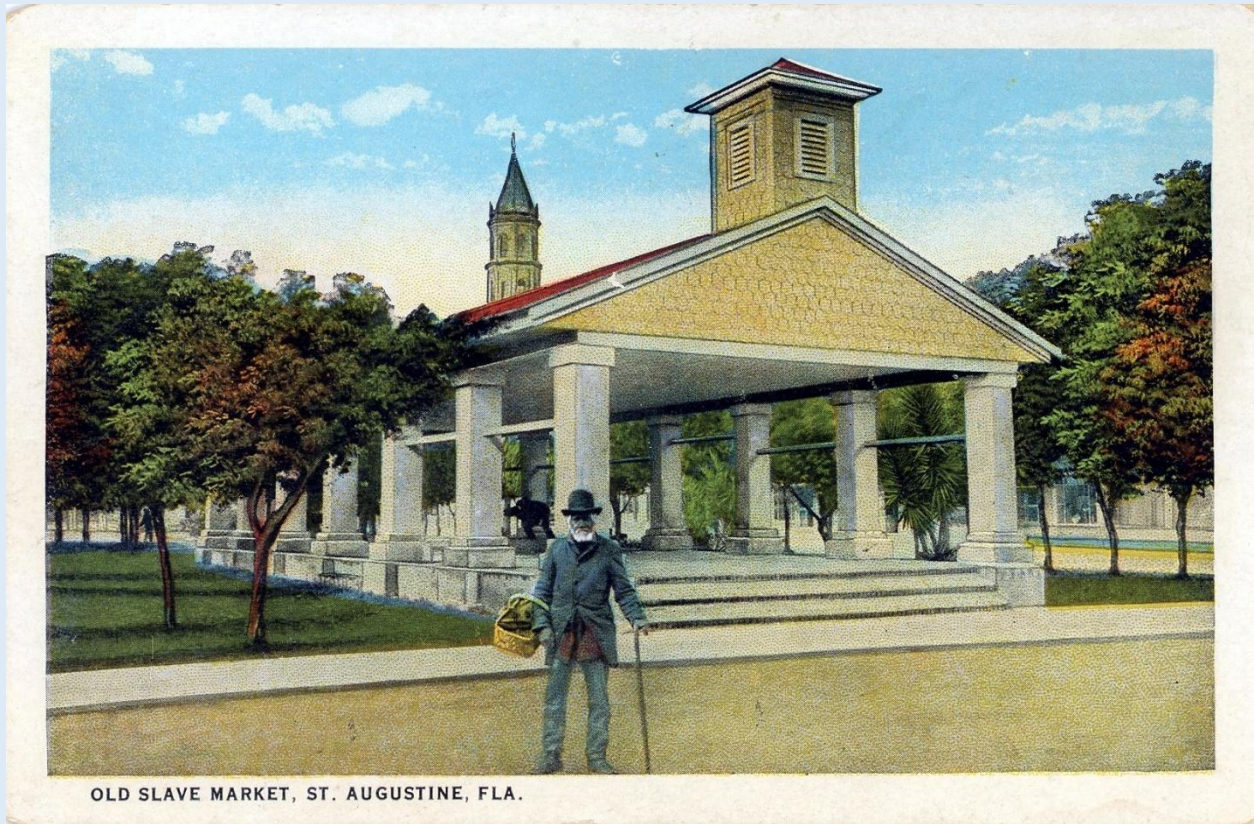

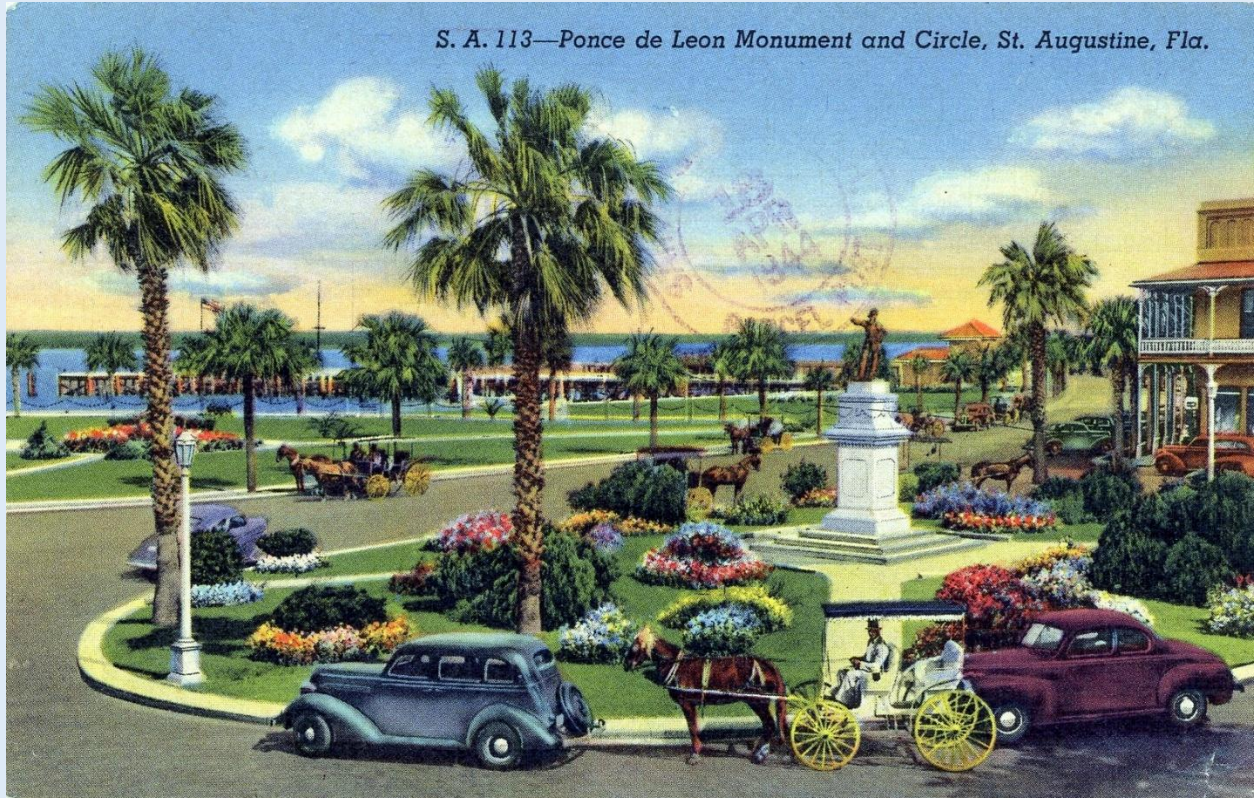

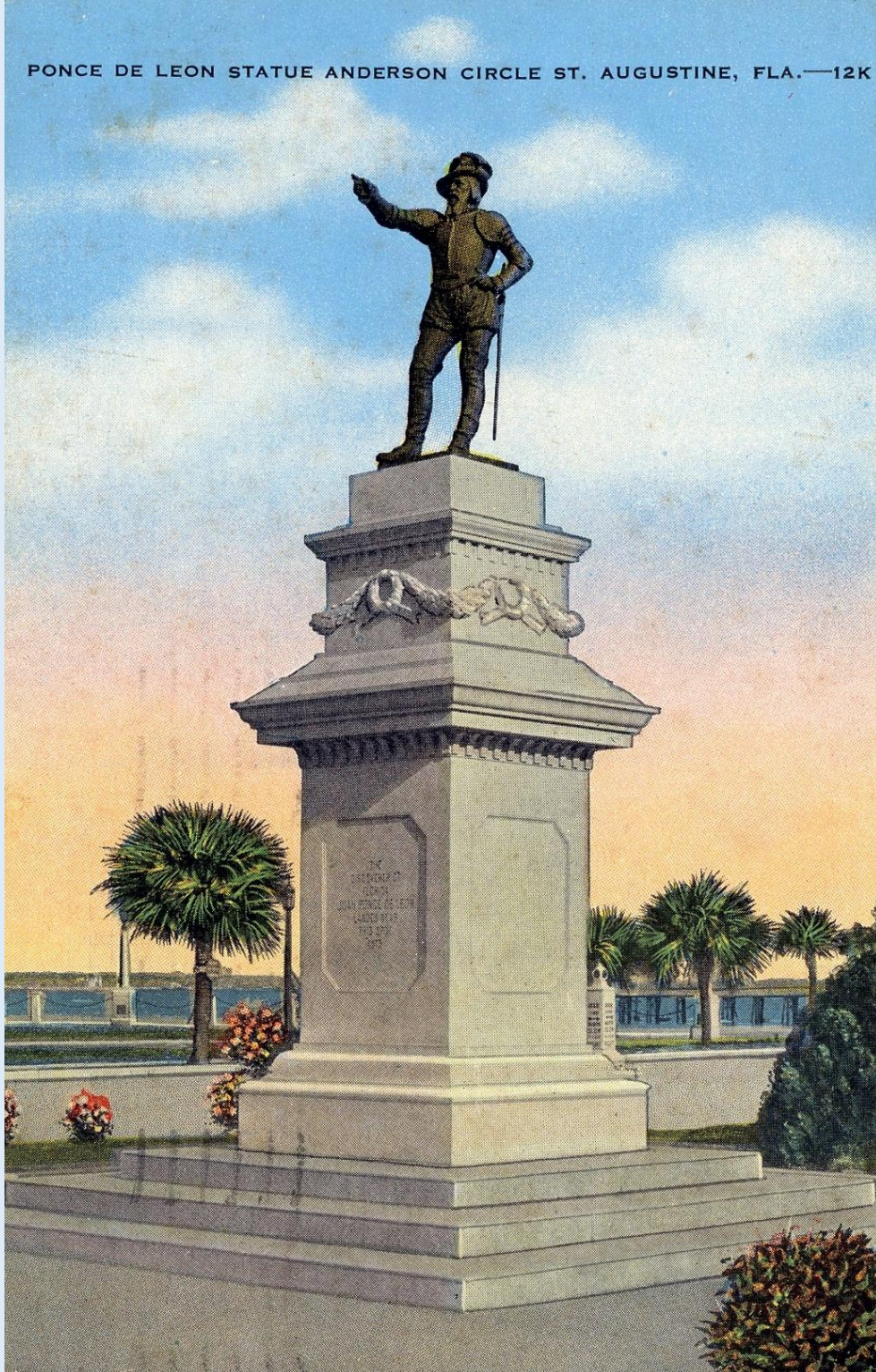

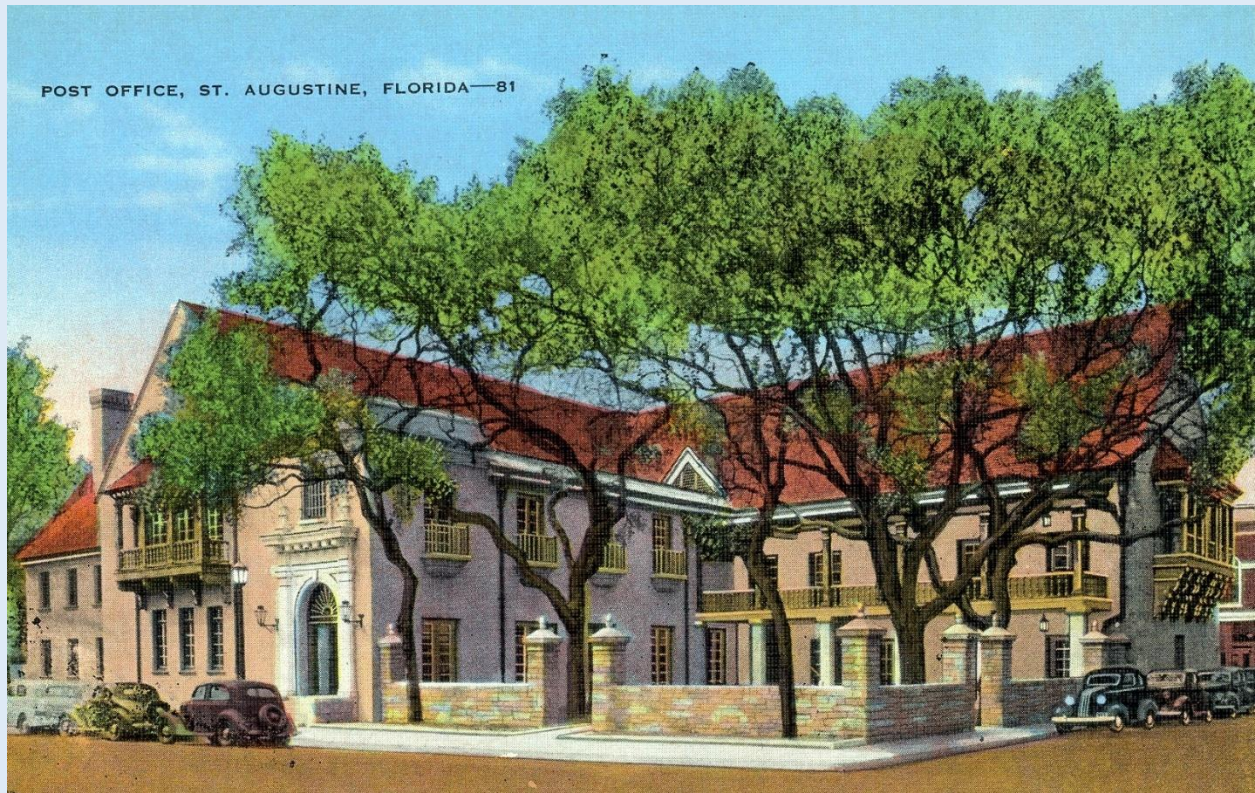

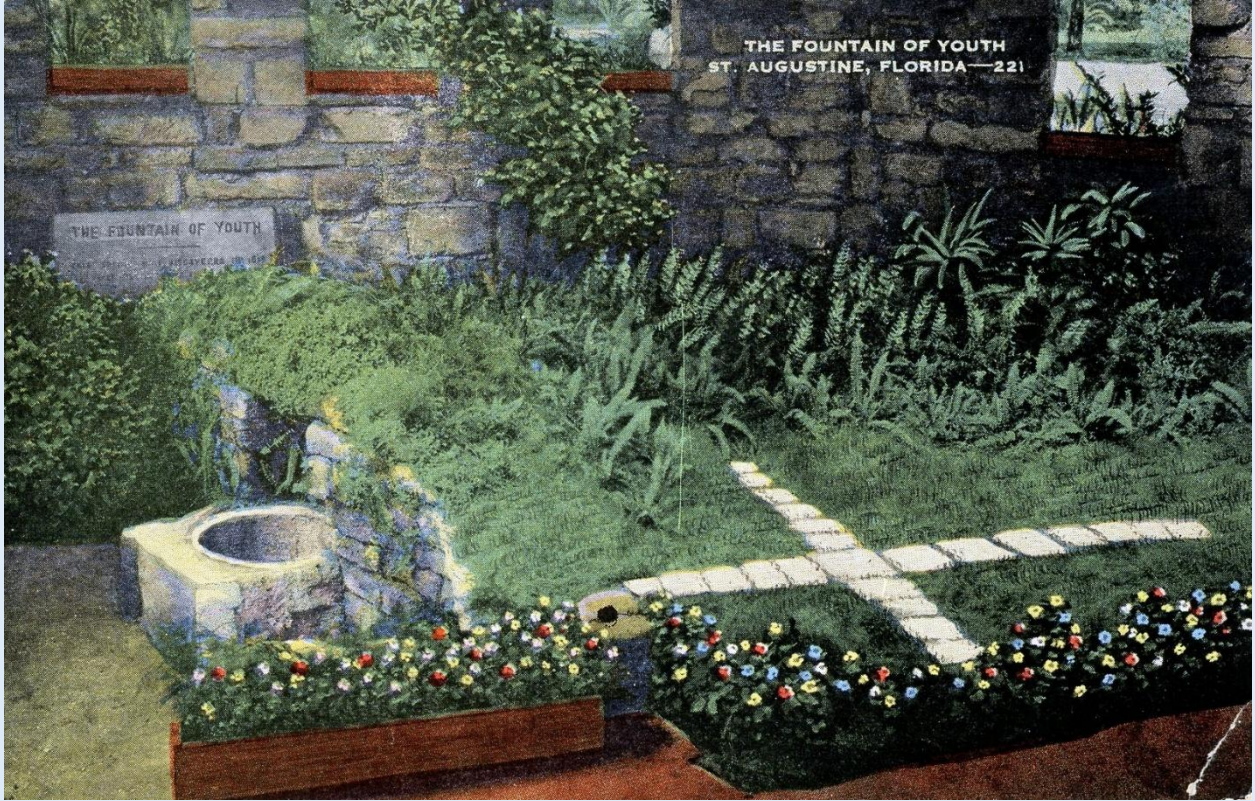

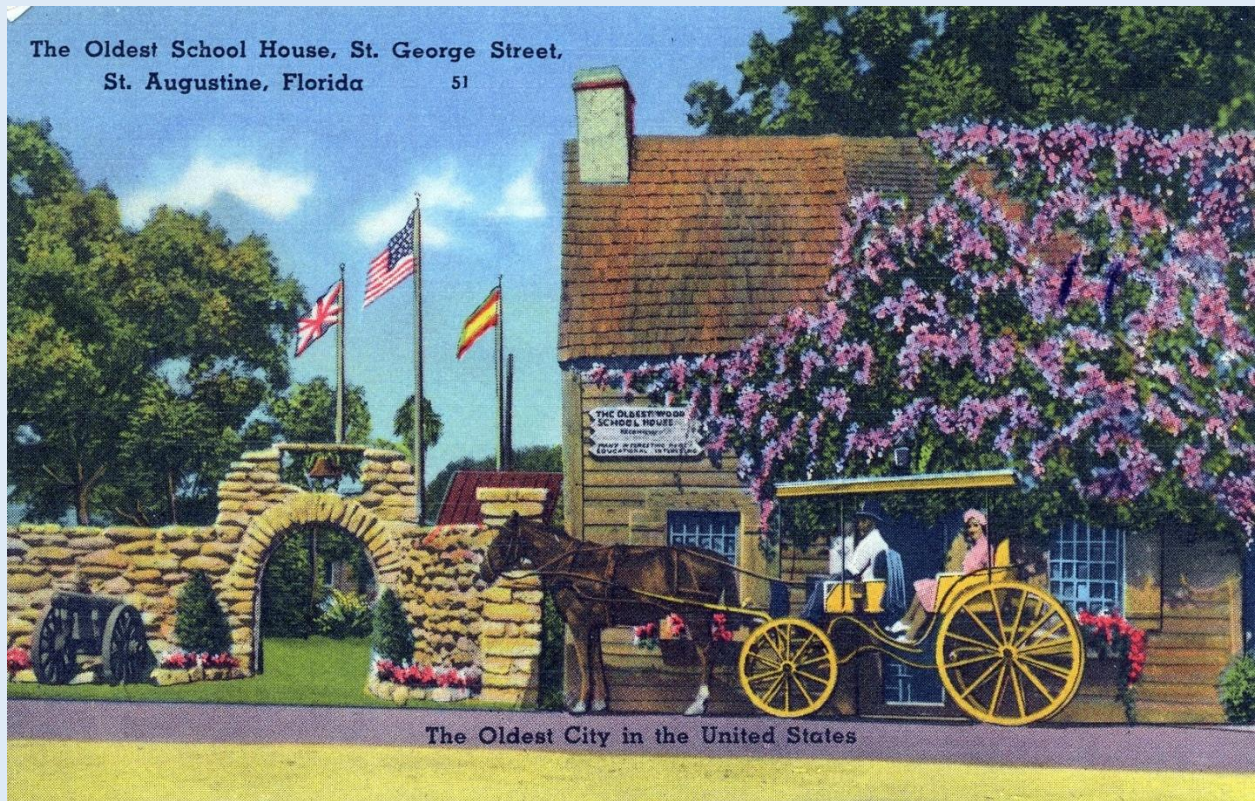

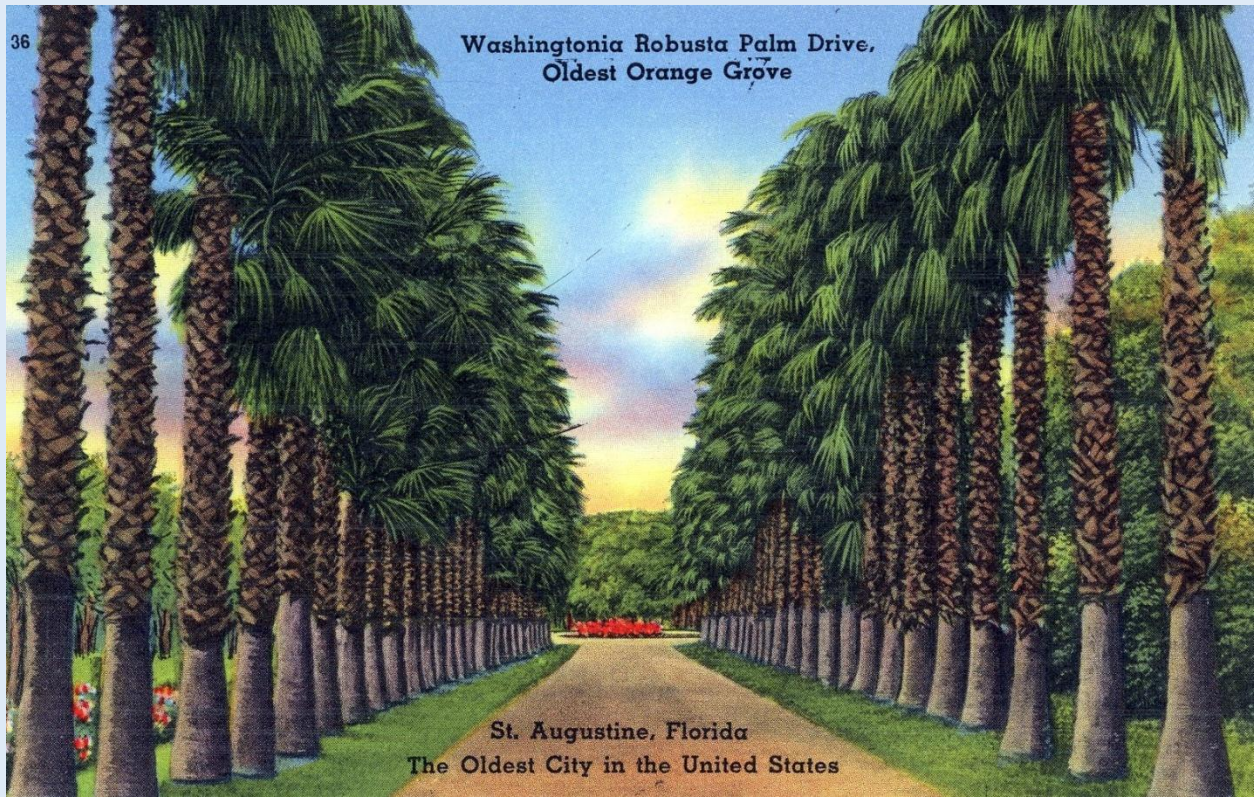
